

Scrapbook instructions for



Primary Age (ages 4-8)

The family notebook will be one of your child's first scrapbooking projects with the Hearthstone Education Plan. When young children study family history for their first history lessons, they are nurturing a sense of belonging. They belong a family here on earth and they also belong to a heavenly family. This notebook allows them to record sketches, diagrams, short stories and maps that pertain to both an earthly family and heavenly family.

Supplies:

- 3 Ring binder with clear cover for page insert or scrapbook binder
- Blank page inserts for scrapbook
- Line page inserts for scrapbook
- Crayons, color pencils
- Plastic page protectors, if desired
- Other artistic supplies including photographs, design paper, stickers, glue, etc.

Instructions:

- Children may design a cover page for their scrapbook by sketching and coloring a picture of their family, their home, a family tree, or other image that represents family life
- Sample page ideas for inside scrapbook:
 - About Me page (include hair color, eye color, favorite colors, favorite hobbies, etc.)
 - o My Father page
 - My Mother page
 - My Brother(s) page(s)
 - My Sister(s) page(s)
 - My Grandfather(s) paternal and maternal
 - My Grandmother(s) paternal and maternal
 - o Pages for other ancestors, aunts, uncles, and cousins
 - My Story (short biography about the child)
 - Family Stories Section
 - Include short stories about family members. Allow child to write or dictate the story, depending on writing skills. Allow child to sketch some pictures to go with the story
 - Family location
 - o Include a picture of the home and a map of the community or neighborhood
 - Other pages as desired
